RETREAT

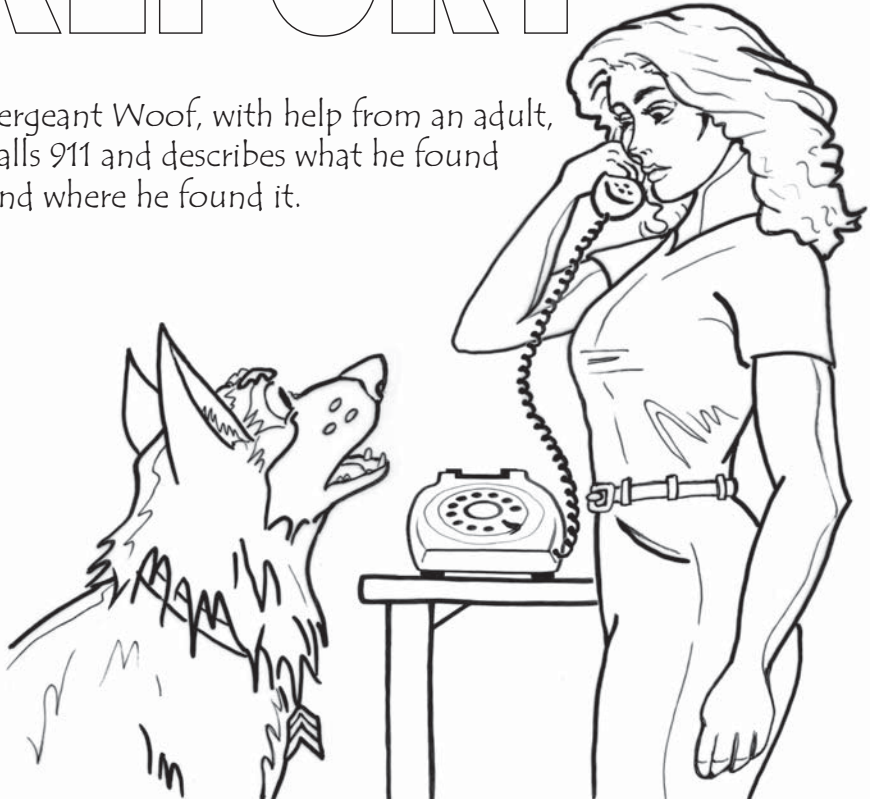


Don't touch it!

REPORT

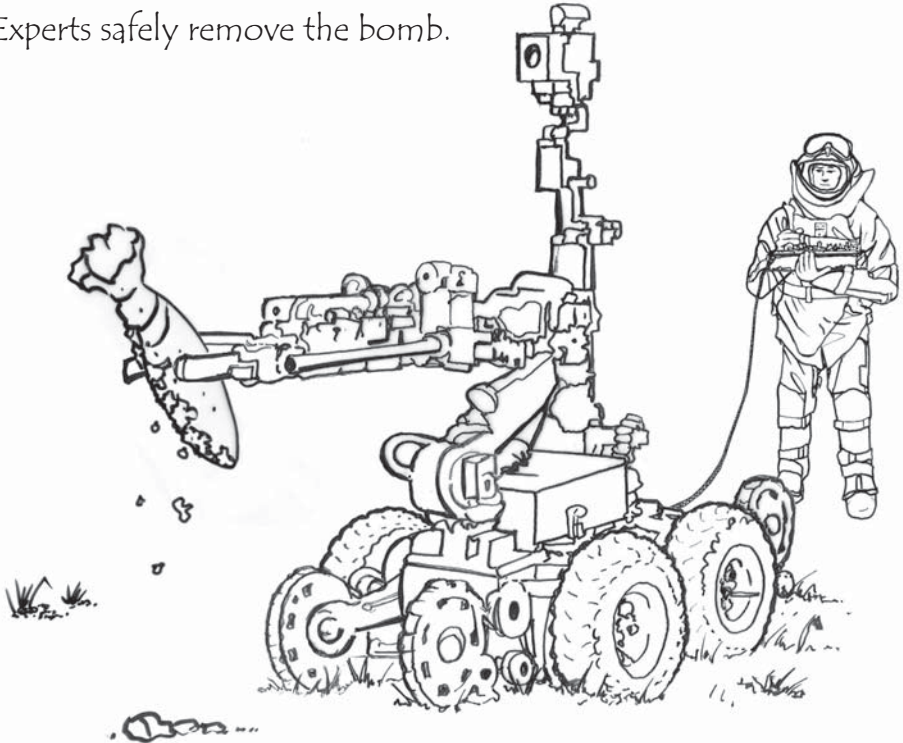
Sergeant Woof, with help from an adult, calls 911 and describes what he found and where he found it.
