The mother went on to say, "I didn't think it was dangerous, I just thought it was old, I said no one will want that, you can put it up on your shelf with your other toys."



But when mom decided to show the grenade to a neighbor, he pointed out that, while the pin was missing, it might still contain some explosives and could be dangerous. That's when she phoned the police to report the find.

The Northumbria Police responded and evacuated the area before calling in a Royal Navy EOD team to respond. EOD safely transported the grenade from the house for proper disposal.
