This is a volunteer program and those who choose this field are specially trained at Naval Explosive Ordnance Disposal School at Eglin AFB, Florida.

There are over 7,000 brave men and women serving within our four services. They are responsible for disarming, rendering safe and disposing of a variety of unexploded ordnance and terrorist devices, normally called Improvised Explosive Devices or IEDs. These devices are responsible for the majority of fatalities and severe injuries on today's battlefields.
