Washington, D.C. The USACE released an updated version of ER 385-1-95, *Safety and Health Requirements for Operations and Activities Involving Munitions and Explosives of Concern (MEC)*. The revised Engineer Regulation (ER) dated 31 December 2014 supersedes the previous version dated March 30, 2007.

The new guidance, which can be downloaded from the <u>UXOInfo.com's UXO Library</u>, contains updated safety and health requirements and responsibilities for military munitions response actions and MEC related operations, including operations involving CWM.

Interesting changes to ER 385-1-95 include the replacement of waivers for explosives operations with Certificates of Compelling Reason (CCR) or Deviation Approval and Risk Acceptance Documents (DARAD) and updated training guidelines for USACE OESS personnel.
